

**Parking and Directions to the Office of the Child Advocate**  
**Trinity-Washington Building**  
**270 Washington Street, S.W.**  
**8<sup>th</sup> Floor**  
**Atlanta, Georgia 30334**

The main entrance for 270 Washington Street is located on Trinity Avenue, and is ADA accessible. Please note that all visitors will need to present picture identification issued by a State or Federal entity prior to entry.

### **Recommended Parking**

Limited metered street parking is available using the Parking Pay Stations machine in front of the main entrance of our building on Trinity Avenue. Most parking meters are \$2.00 per hour. Pay stations accept coins, bills, and credit and debit cards. The minimum payment amount for credit card users is \$1. When parking, please locate your space number, identify the nearest pay station, enter your space number and select your payment option according to the directions at the pay station. Once you have paid for parking at the Parking Pay Station, walk right up to the building on the sidewalk.

Parking is also available next to the Trinity United Methodist Church at the **Government Center Parking Deck** on Washington Street. Parking is \$6 per day if you arrive before 9:00 AM and \$10 if after 9:00 AM. Weekday parking prices range from \$2 for ½ hour of parking to \$10 for 3 hours or more; after 6 p.m. and all day weekend prices are \$4.

### **Directions from Government Center Parking Deck to Conference Location**

- Exit the Government Center Parking Deck out of the Washington Street exit which is located on the 4th floor.
- Walk out to the corner in front of Trinity United Methodist Church which is the corner of Trinity and Washington Street. Walk straight across Washington Street to continue on the block towards Trinity Avenue. The entrance into our building will be to the right.
- When you come into the lobby, please stop at the Security Desk and be prepared to sign in and show picture identification.

### **Travelling I-20 West Bound**

- Exit Capitol Avenue.
- Turn right at end of ramp and go to second traffic light (Martin Luther King Jr. Drive).
- Turn left onto MLK Jr. Drive and go to first traffic light (Washington St.).
- Turn left onto Washington Street. Continue to the second intersection, which is Trinity Avenue.
- The Trinity-Washington building is on the southeast corner of Trinity Avenue and Washington Street.

### **Travelling I-20 East Bound**

- Exit Windsor Street.
- Turn left at end of ramp and keep straight to approximately second light (Trinity Ave.).
- Turn right on Trinity Avenue and go to fifth traffic light (Washington Street).
- Turn right on Washington Street.
- The Trinity-Washington building is on the southeast corner of Trinity Avenue and Washington Street.

### **Travelling I-75/I-85 North Bound**

- Exit Central Avenue and keep straight to approximately third light (Trinity Avenue).
- Turn right on Trinity Avenue and go to first traffic light (Washington Street).
- Turn right on Washington Street
- The Trinity-Washington building is on the southeast corner of Trinity Avenue and Washington Street.

### **Travelling I-75/I-85 South Bound**

- Exit Martin Luther King Jr. Drive and go to third traffic light (Washington Street).
- Turn left onto Washington Street. Continue to the second intersection, which is Trinity Avenue.
- The Trinity-Washington building is on the southeast corner of Trinity Avenue and Washington Street.

### **From MARTA Transit**

- Take the east-west train line of MARTA to the Georgia State station (E1).
- As you leave the train, proceed down the stairs and follow the station signs to exit toward Piedmont Avenue. Look for the sign that says "Capitol" (you will be heading south.)
- At the intersection of Martin Luther King Drive (MLK) and Piedmont Ave., cross MLK, then cross Piedmont. You will be on the same side of the street as the Capitol building (southwest corner of the intersection).
- Proceed west along MLK one block to Washington Avenue.
- Turn left on Washington Street (south) and continue another 2 blocks to Trinity Avenue. The Trinity-Washington building is on the southeast corner of the intersection, directly across the street from the church with red doors (Trinity United Methodist Church).
