Georgia Neurobehavioral Associate's Social Skills Training Programs target children who may have a diagnosis of an Autism Spectrum Disorder or Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD). However, your child does not need to have a diagnosis to participate and benefit from social skills training.

Through utilizing each child's unique profile of social interaction and strategic guidance, each child will develop new social competencies to increase their ability to initiate and maintain relationships as well as solve conflicts. The peer groups will be evenly matched with peer partners who share similar social challenges and take place in a non-threatening environment.

The Social Skills Groups will be led by Board Certified Behavior Analysts and Licensed Psychologists. The evidence-based curriculum and lessons will be offered once per week for six weeks. Groups cost Fifty dollars per session.
