

 - Provide training in Youth Mental Health First Aid


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

Youth and young adults face and experience mental health challenges the same as adults.










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
U.S. Youth with a Mental Disorder during Adolescence (Age 13-18)



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	Prevalence (%)	With severe impact (%)
Anxiety disorders	31.9	8.3
Behavior disorders	19.1	9.6
Mood disorders	14.3	11.2
Substance use disorders	11.4	11.4
Overall prevalence (with severe impact)		27.6





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
