

# BY THE NUMBERS 2017

- 95% of our clients are low income
- 81% of our clients live in poverty
- On average, CCA spends \$395 per client to deliver services
- 80% of CCA's funds raised are used for direct client services

**Catholic Charities Atlanta served 16,358 clients in 2017**

- 319 refugees welcomed from 19 countries
- 937 individuals from 60 countries consulted with our Immigration Legal Team
- 27 survivors of domestic violence, crime, and trafficking given life-changing legal and social service support
- 120 callers received referrals when our services did not meet their immediate needs
- 3,359 individuals received Christmas gifts
- 3,643 baby supply donations distributed
- 222 clients engaged in mental health counseling to improve their lives
- 76 outreach events, attended by staff, reached 5,145 people in our communities

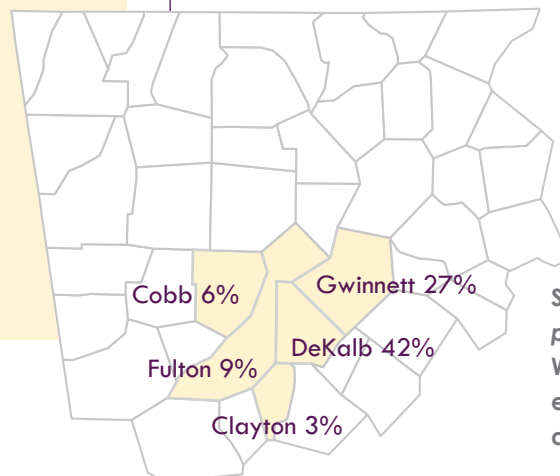
## Families

- 63% of CCA's Home Buyer Education Seminar participants purchase a home within 1 year
- 65% of foreclosure intervention clients maintain housing for at least 6 months
- 62% of households in our Public Benefits program reduced the risk of going without food by gaining sustaining food security (SNAP)

## New Americans

- 96% of refugees in the employment program are economically self-sufficient within 6 months of arriving to the US
- Average hourly wage of their first job is \$10.04
- 60% of ESL students advance a full level of English proficiency

- 93% of refugee students in our after-school program improve reading ability
- 93% of refugee youth in the Mentoring Program show no gang-related involvement
- 96% of parents in the in-home parenting program improve their relationship with their child(ren)

## Volunteers

- 874 volunteers served this past year
- 24,934 hours of service totaling \$489,371 in donated value
- 96% of our volunteers felt welcomed and appreciated

## Veterans

- 98% of veteran clients understand available resources because of CCA's help
- 89% of veteran services involve direct financial assistance
